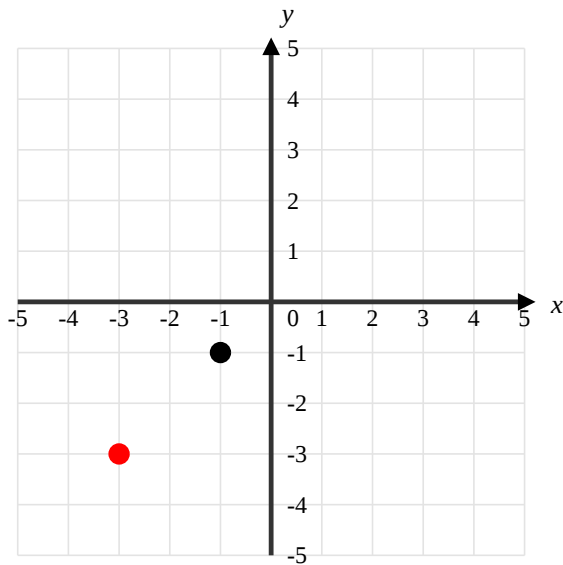
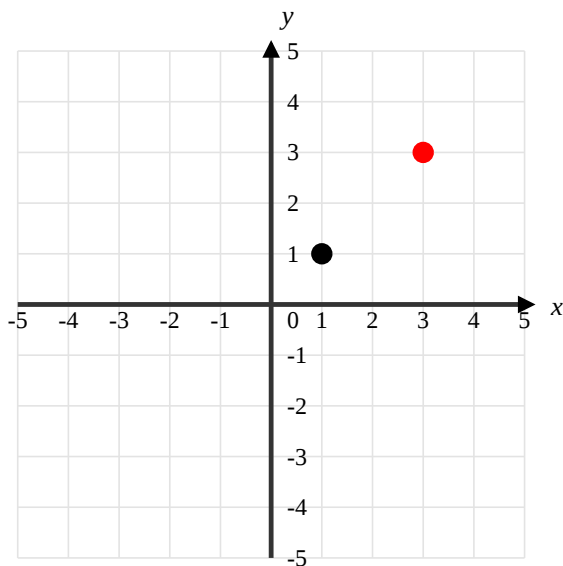


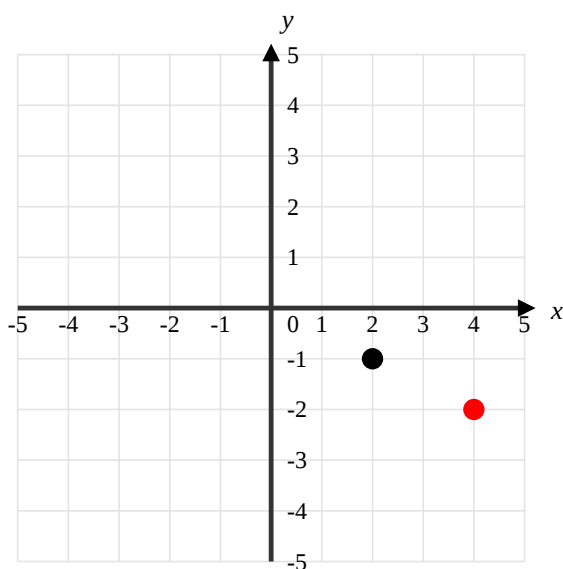
Solutions – Enlargement (A)

about the origin.

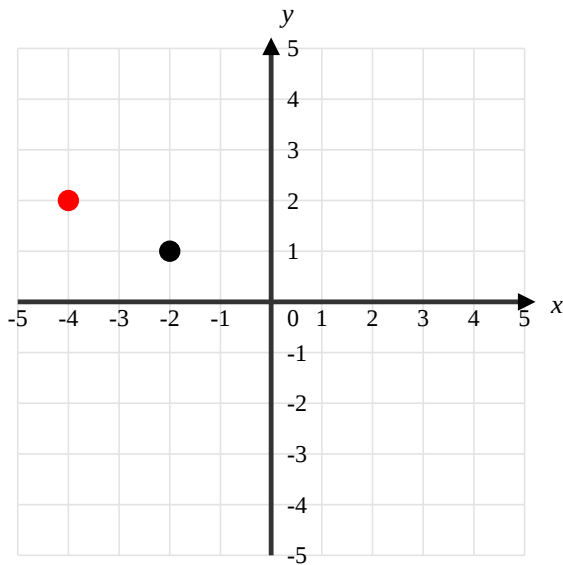


The point $(1, 1)$ is shown on the grid.

about the origin.

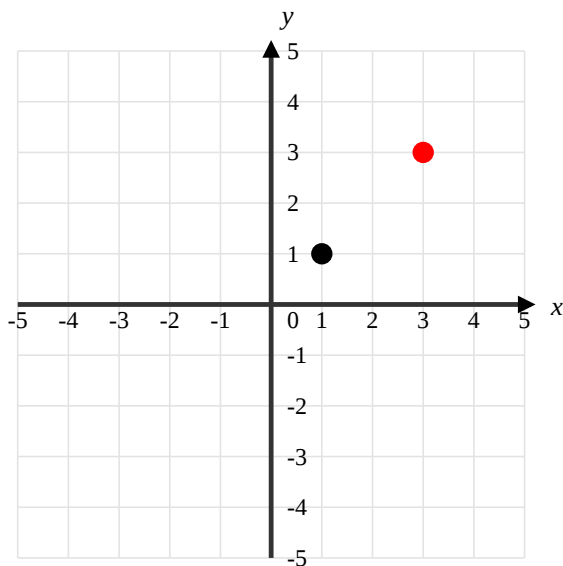


The point $(2, -1)$ is shown on the grid.

about the origin.

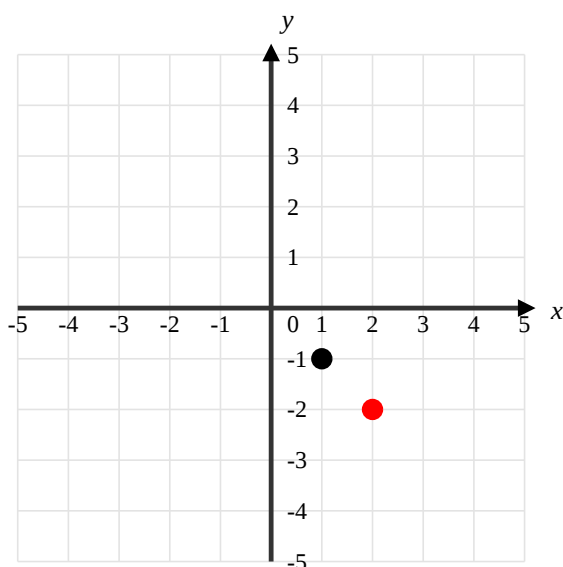
Solutions – Enlargement (B)

about the origin.

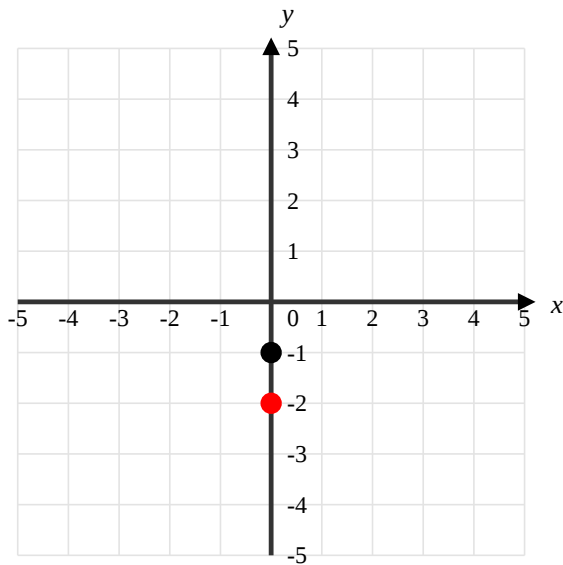


The point $(1, 1)$ is shown on the grid.

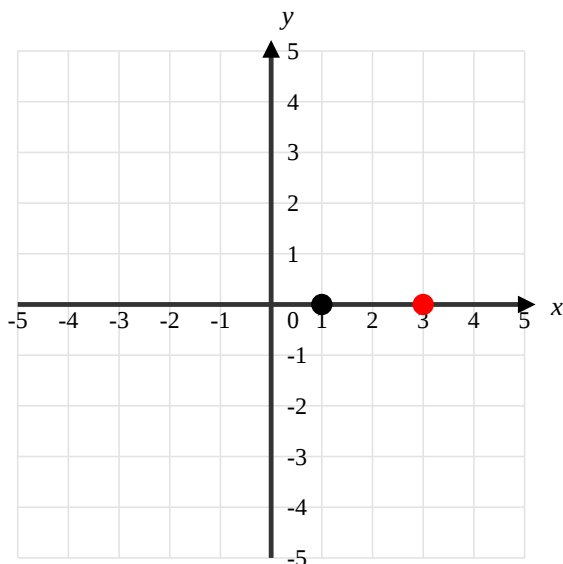


The point $(1, -1)$ is shown on the grid.

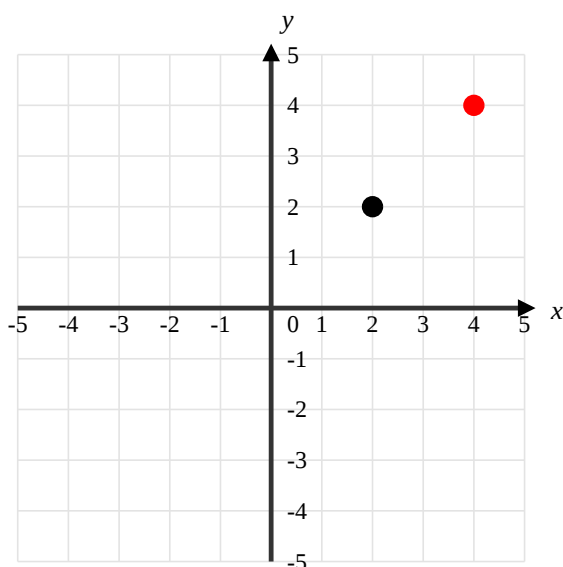

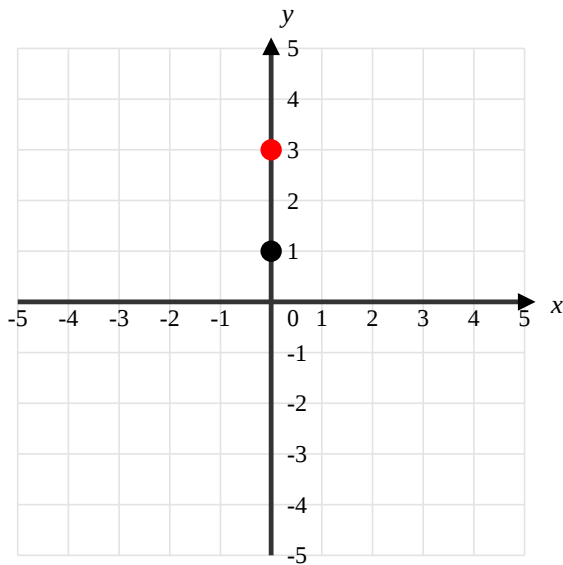

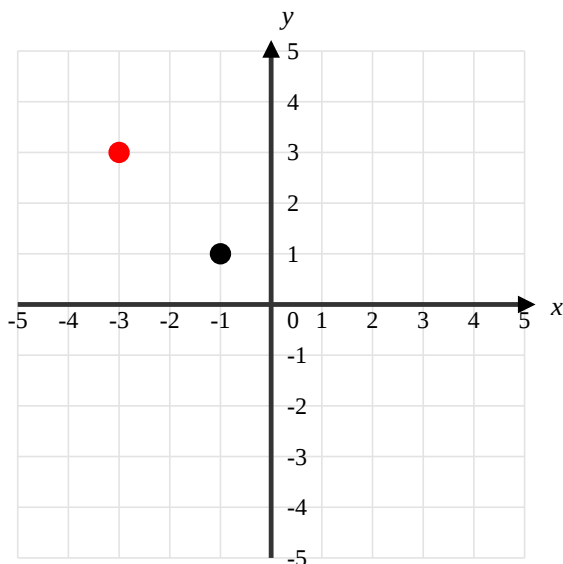

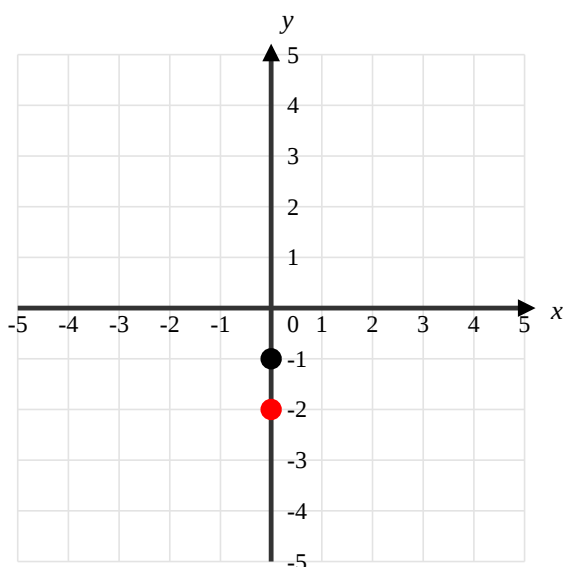

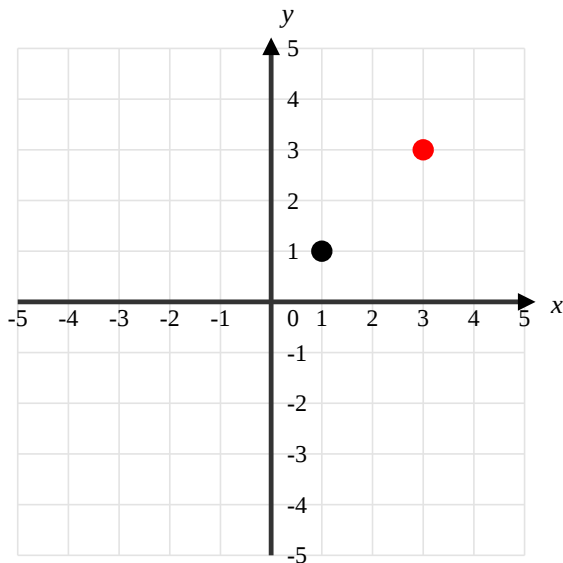

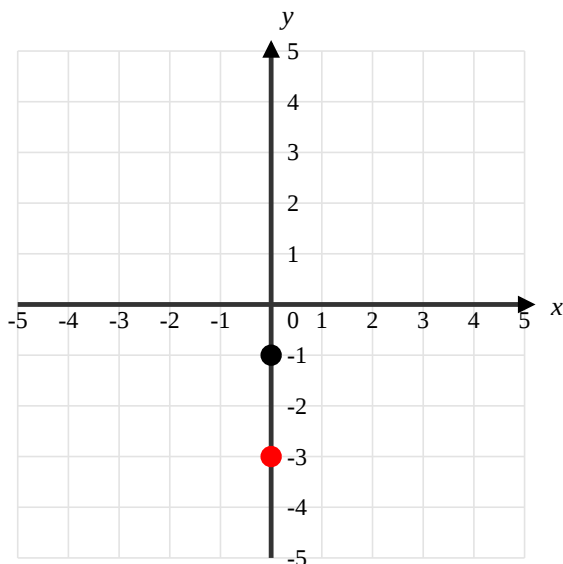

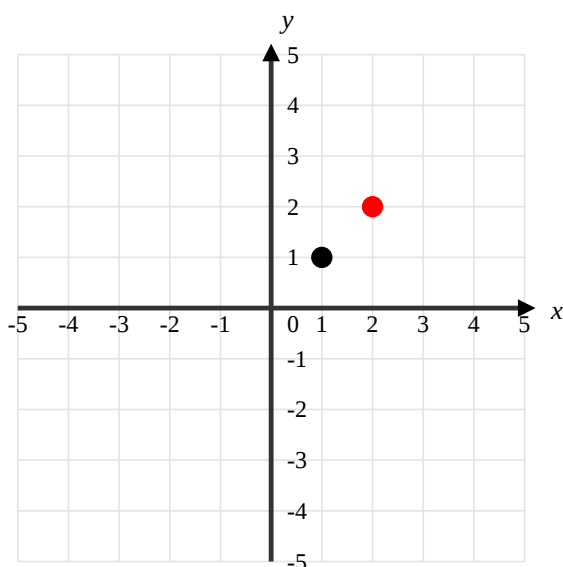

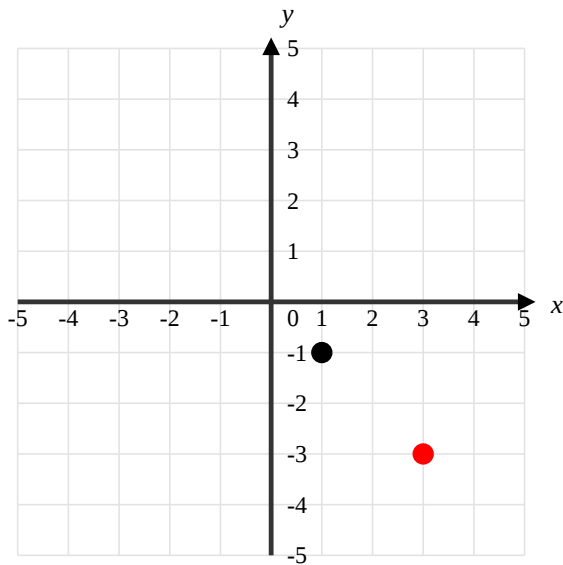

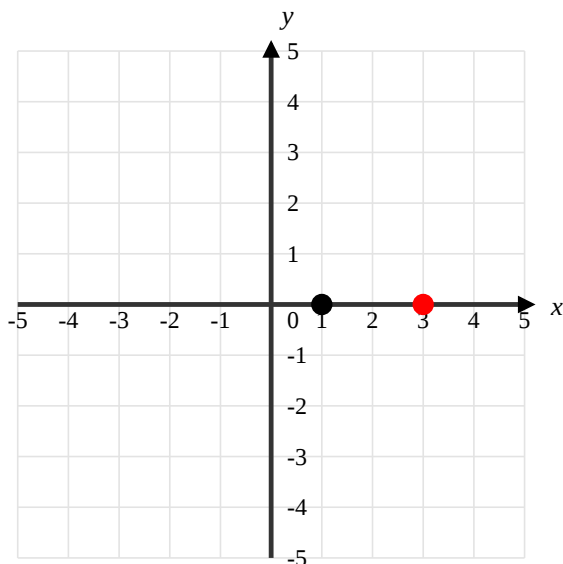

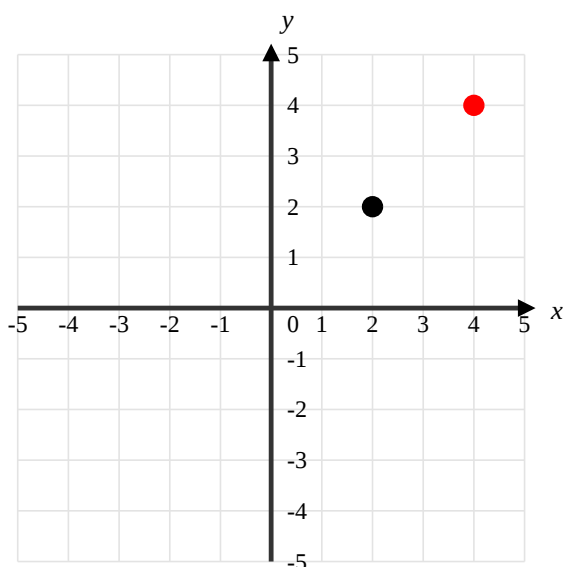

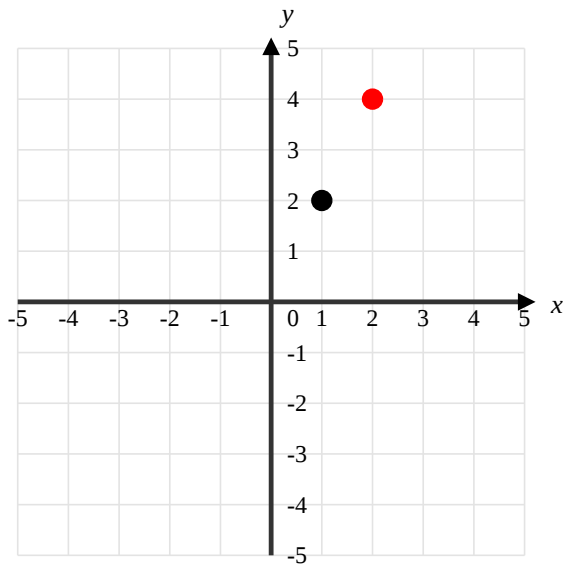

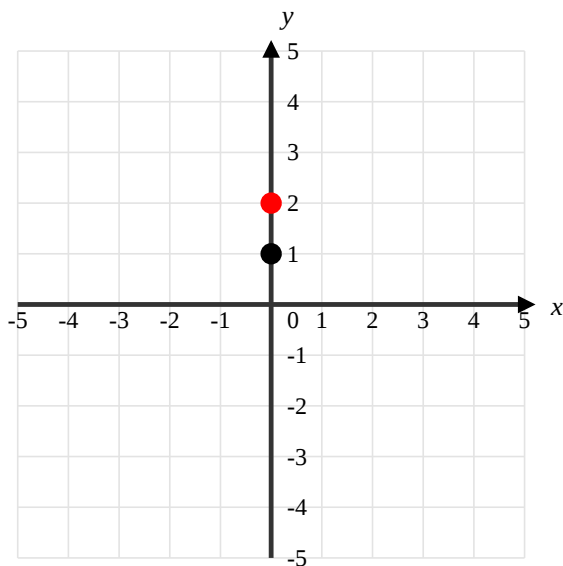

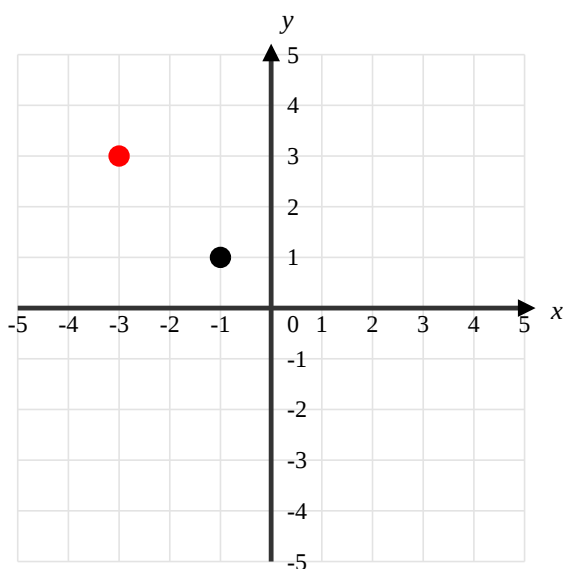

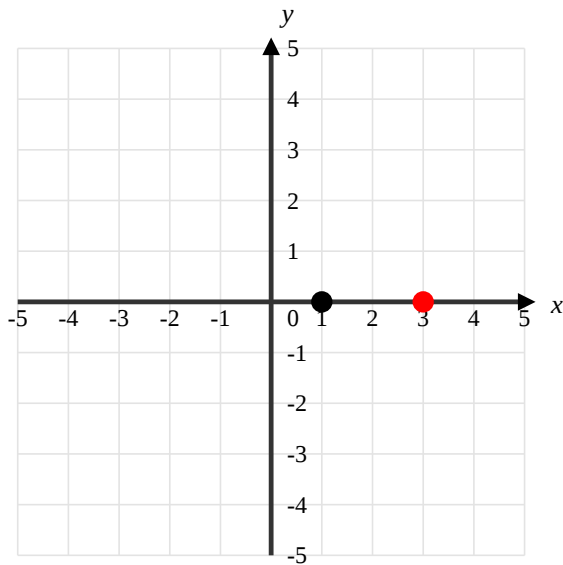

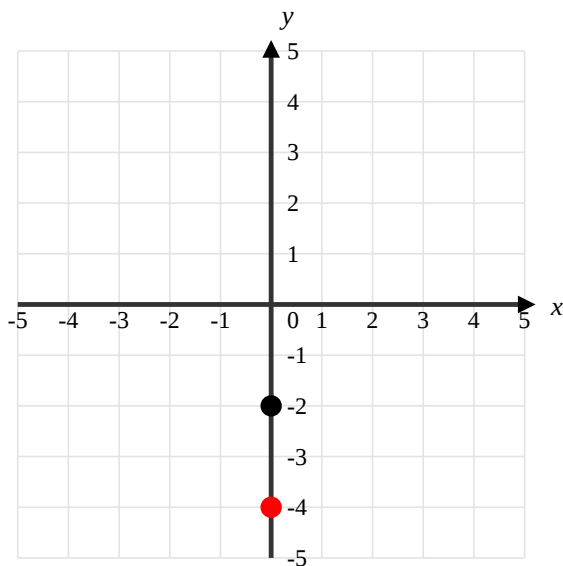

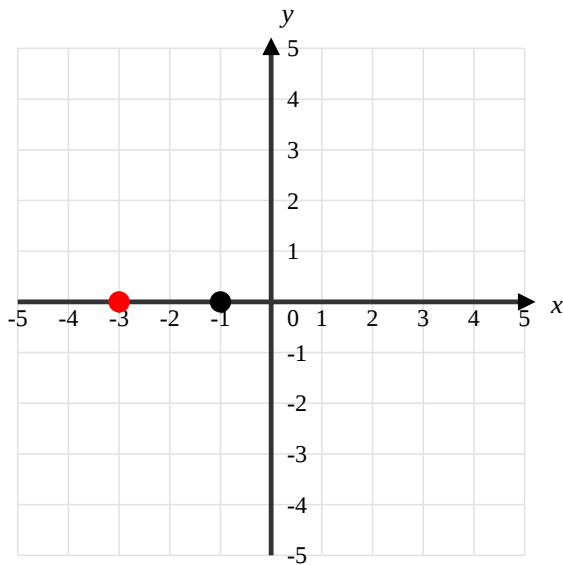

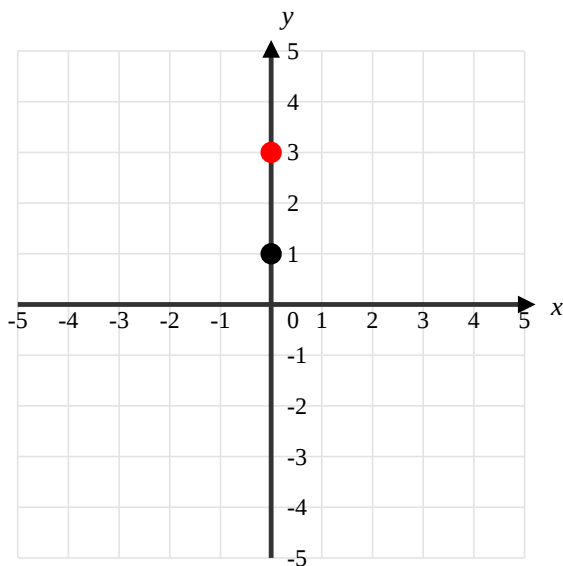

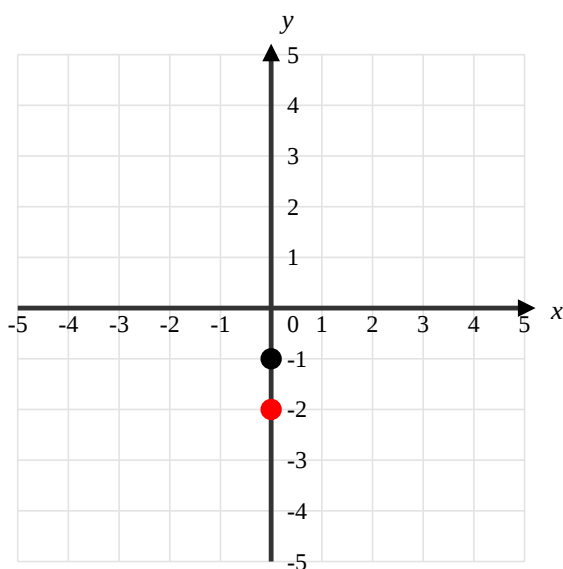

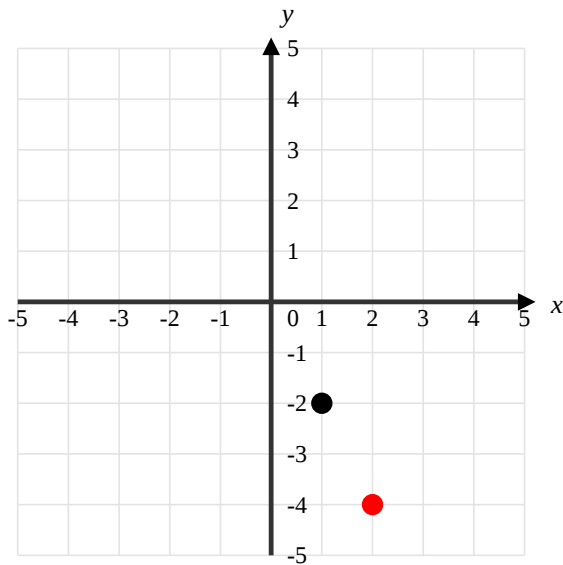

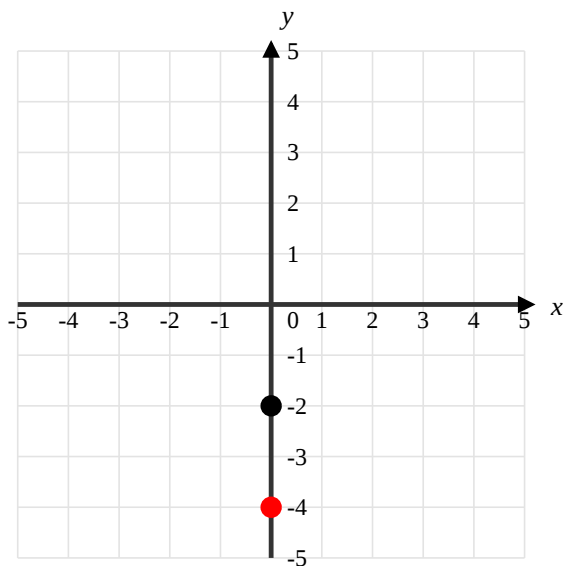

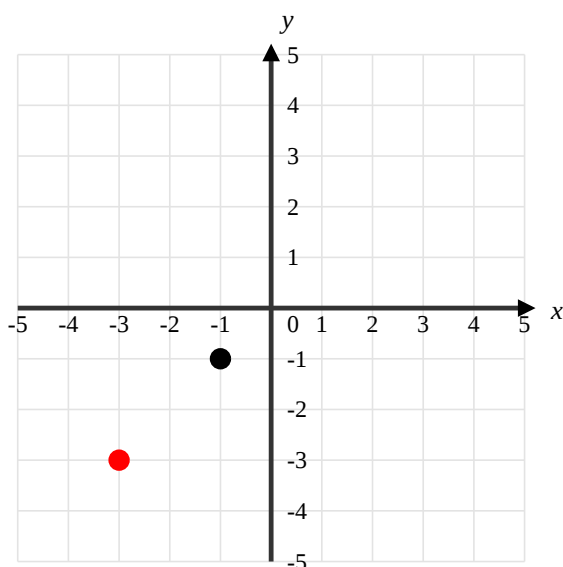
